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Behaviour Management Policy

Rationale:

Paekakariki School believes in a shared and positive approach to managing pupil behaviour.

By ensuring that:

- Shared rules and expectations are clear to staff, children, parents and caregivers.
- Staff is positive, yet firm and consistent with discipline.
- Children experience stimulating and challenging classroom programmes.
- Children are encouraged to engage in positive activities at playtimes to ensure that behavioural problems will be kept to a minimum.

Guiding Document: Paekakariki School Behaviour Management Scheme

Purposes

1. To provide clear guidelines for children as to their rights and responsibilities
2. To ensure all children, staff, parents and caregivers know the expected standards of behaviour.
3. To ensure all procedures for dealing with unacceptable behaviour are known.
4. To encourage a positive approach to student behaviour management.
5. To require children to practise acceptable standards of behaviour and encourage self discipline.
6. To have a clear set of behavioural steps to deal with problem behaviour.
7. To involve parents and caregivers in helping maintain acceptable standards of behaviour.

Guidelines

1. The Schools Behaviour Management Scheme should be referred to for any behavioural problems.
2. Parents/Caregivers will be contacted and their support enlisted when required.
3. Consequences will be fair and reasonable and be known by the children.
